The River Gambia is one of the favourite and richest fishing spots in the African sub region. It obtains its source from the Futa Jallon highlands in Guinea and opens up to the vast Atlantic Ocean thus providing a unique combination of flora and fauna.

The fishing spots are accurately selected with a valuable knowledge of the fish and fishing grounds offering the angler the rare opportunity to catch the "Big One". Fishing methods would take the form of live baiting, dead baiting, drifting, trolling, etc. The anglers would be provided with live or dead baits or artificial ones depending on their choice of fish predator.

The prized fishes would include both fast moving fish and dormant fish. They include the famous Baracuda, the golden Snapper, the flamboyant Cassava Fish, Captain, Tarpon (also referred to as Silver Queens), Sting Ray just to name a few.

Participation:

- Entry Fee: £125 per day (Covers transportation, bait, water, boat and Awards Gala Dinner.
- £6000 worth of prizes to be awarded on various prize categories.
- Competition is on full insurance cover with support from Gambia Maritime Administration, The Gambia Fire and Rescue Services, Gambia Navy and Department of Fisheries.
- Closing date for entry into the competition is 31st October 2015.
